XL-EDIFY Schools Out Camp - COVID-19 Plan & Response:

Parents/Guardians are responsible for submitting, per week, their child's virtual schooling schedules and guidelines to XL Management:

1. Check in procedure:

- a. Check-in time will take place from 8:30 AM-9:30 AM
- b. Parents/guardians needing to drop off after this time frame will have to call ahead so we can expect them and do the temperature check etc.
- c. Campers will be dropped off by car at the front of the building
- d. One XL Staff member will be at a table with a laptop for DASH check in
- e. XL Staff will provide a forehead temperature screening
- f. Campers must have an acceptable pediatric temperature of 100.4 degrees fahrenheit or less to attend camp.
- g. Campers found to have a higher temperature, still after a second or more reading, will be asked to return to their parent(s)/guardian(s) vehicle and will be informed via an email or phone call from XL Management that they must maintain a 14 day quarantine period away from camp. Returning to camp will require a Doctor's note that they're fit to return.
- h. Campers passing this check in procedure will be brought into the building and directed by a front desk member of XL staff to the concourse bleachers area. This will be setup to maintain as much social distance as we can realistically handle. Here the staff will begin forming children into the groups they will remain in for the week.
- i. This area will have an XL member of staff or two to help supervise until the main camp is underway at around 9:00 am.
- j. After 9:00 AM, Campers will be separated into groups for their required virtual schooling times and those not on a virtual school schedule will be separated to

proceed to the sports and recreation game area (Turf 1, 2 or the basketball courts). During this time, XL will breakdown groups based on ages (Age groups will depend on daily age population counts of the camp)

Activities/games that will played in a rotational basis during camp:

(Groups are socially distanced as much as possible through our conference rooms during virtual schooling times as well as during sports and rec games throughout out 78,000 square foot building. XL keeps a 10:1 ratio of campers to XL Staff)

2. Lunch:

- a. Campers are encouraged to bring a bagged lunch until Pennsylvania

 Department of Health COVID-19 mitigation efforts are lifted
- b. XL will still be providing optional lunches for \$6.00 per day per camper including items such as (Depending on COVID-19 restrictions per week/month):
 - i. Grilled cheese
 - ii. Pizza
 - iii. Hot dogs
 - iv. Chicken tenders
 - 1. Sides for all aforementioned food items will include a choice of: chips, fries, fruit cup/veggies as well as water/juice as a drink

3. Pick up procedure:

- a. Pick up time will take place from 4:30 PM-5:30 PM
- b. Parents/guardians needing to pick up before this time frame will have to call ahead so we can expect them
- c. One XL Staff member will be at a table with a laptop for DASH check in
- d. Parents will pull up to the front doors, remaining in their vehicles and inform the check out XL staff member of who they're picking up, this staff member will let the front desk XL staff member know who is to be picked up, that member of staff will find them in camp and bring them out to the checkout area

e. The checkout staff will walk them to the parent/guardian's car. ID will need to be verified before XL released the camper into the vehicle

4. Sick camper processes:

- a. Any campers complaining of feeling ill (Coughing, fever and general malaise), will be taken aside by XL staff and given a temperature screening.
- b. The camper will also then be brought to the designated isolation room to rest away from the general population of camp
- c. They will be given a disposable cup of water to hydrate
- d. The camper will be kept comfortable in the isolation room until their parent/guardian is able to pick them up from camp
- e. XL management staff will need to call their parent/guardian for pick up, clearly informing the parent/guardian they will need to call once they arrive so their camper may be brought to the car
- f. XL management staff will send an email or call the parents that the camper needs a doctor's note showing they are fit to return to camp

5. <u>Isolation room for sick campers</u>

- a. The isolation room will be the conference room, back offices, first room on left
- b. This room will be thoroughly disinfected and cleaned prior to any camper entering it and immediately after
- c. Disinfection will be completed by a gloved and masked XL manager using the stronger "red," concentrated Envirox solution on all chairs and table surfaces in the room and paper towels which will be throw into a clear plastic bag and thrown away immediately
- d. Staff having completed this task will also need to throw away the gloves used in this process and thoroughly wash their hands for over 20 seconds with soap and water, followed by hand sanitizer
- e. The TV should be wheeled in so campers in isolation can watch an age appropriate movie until they are picked up, they may also be given the option to color/draw etc. Essentially it will be modified free time

6. XL Staff requirements:

- a. Staff will be required to use their own masks (State guidelines allow for homemade masks)
- b. Gloves are to be worn with any physical interaction with campers
- c. Hands must be washed before and after any direct physical interaction with campers, thoroughly, with soap and water, for over 20 seconds
- d. No high fives, hand shakes etc. will be permitted by XL staff to campers
- e. Cell phones and other non-essential belongings should be kept behind the desk at all times.

7. XL Sanitation:

a. XL Staff will continue to deep clean all common touch surface areas using appropriate cleaning solutions such as Envirox H2O2 Orange etc.

- b. XL Staff will be mopping all common traffic areas utilizing bleach, Envirox H2O2 Orange etc.
- c. XL Staff will interact with all campers and their electronics using single use gloves
- d. Hand sanitizer is available in centralized areas to all campers at all times
- e. Restrooms are deep cleaned utilizing the above solutions on a regular basis
- f. XL restrooms will be kept stocked with plenty of hand soap and stools for younger campers to be able to appropriately wash their hands in the sinks
- g. All equipment and sports balls are sanitized at various times during the programs and activities again utilizing the above solution methods
- h. XL will not be utilizing any pinnies during sports and recreational games/activites
